

Woodland United Methodist Church Endowment Fund

Some of you may not know that the Woodland United Methodist Church has an endowment fund where donated money is reinvested annually and only dividends and interest from the money invested is available for distribution.

Our Permanent Endowment Fund was established in 1997 for the purpose of providing members and friends of the church the opportunity to make charitable gifts to the church that will be a permanent endowment of financial support and a living memorial to loved ones.

The fund is intended to provide additional funds to ministries of the church.

Gifts to the Permanent Endowment Fund may be placed in any of the following categories designated by the donor:

1. Mission Fund
2. Building Fund
3. Unrestricted Fund
4. Children and Youth Ministries Fund
5. Music Fund
6. Scholarship Fund
7. Perpetuity Pledge Fund

The fund is administered by our church's Planned Giving Committee, with oversight provided by our church's Board of Trustees.

Investing and accounting services are provided by the California-Nevada United Methodist Foundation.

You can support the Foundation by remembering the Church when you desire to give ongoing support to the church and/or creating a living memorial for a friend or loved one.
